Your privacy matters to us. This Privacy Policy explains how we collect, use, and protect your information when you visit our website or interact with our content.

1. Information We Collect

We may collect the following types of information:

a) Information You Provide Voluntarily

When you:

- Subscribe to the newsletter
- Submit an event
- Contact us
- Participate in surveys

This may include:

- Name
- Email address
- Social handles (optional)
- Event or submission details

b) Automatically Collected Information

When you visit our website, we may collect:

- IP address
- Device type

- Browser type
- Pages visited
- Referring links
- General location (city-level)

This helps us understand how people use Menna.

c) Cookies and Tracking Technologies

We may use cookies and similar tools to:

- Improve website performance
- Understand traffic patterns
- Personalize content
- Analyze engagement

You can disable cookies in your browser settings.

2. How We Use Your Information

We use your information to:

- Send newsletters and updates
- Improve the Menna experience
- Respond to messages or submissions
- Understand audience interests
- Develop new features or content

We do not sell your personal data.

3. Newsletter Communications

If you subscribe to Menna emails:

- You may receive editorial content, updates, and announcements
- You can unsubscribe anytime using the link in any email
- We use trusted third-party email platforms (e.g., Beehiiv, Substack, or similar)

4. Event Submissions and Community Contributions

If you submit events or materials:

- We may store your contact information
- We may publish submitted details publicly
- You can request removal or corrections at any time

5. Third-Party Services

We may use trusted third-party services for:

- Email delivery
- Analytics (e.g., Google Analytics, Plausible, etc.)
- Form submissions
- Website hosting

These providers may process data according to their own privacy policies.

6. External Links

Menna often links to third-party platforms, including:

- Instagram
- Eventbrite
- Ticketmaster

- Venue websites

Once you leave Menna, we are not responsible for how those platforms handle your data.

We encourage reviewing their privacy policies.

7. Data Sharing

We do not sell, rent, or trade personal information.

We may share data only when necessary to:

- Operate the platform (e.g., email providers)
- Comply with legal obligations
- Protect Menna's rights or users

8. Data Retention

We retain personal data only as long as necessary to:

- Provide services
- Maintain records
- Improve the platform

You can request deletion at any time (see Section 12)

9. Children's Privacy

Menna is not intended for children under 18.

We do not knowingly collect personal data from minors.

If you believe a child has provided data, please contact us and we will remove it.

10. Your Rights
